



Notice to Parents from PERM-A-PLEAT SCHOOLWEAR RETAIL SHOP – LUMEN CHRISTI COLLEGE

In order to provide its ongoing service to the families of Lumen Christi College by purchasing and selling second hand uniforms, Perm-A-Pleat Schoolwear wishes to advise the following changes and new conditions.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE FOR SECOND HAND UNIFORMS - FOR SALE BY CONSIGNMENT

In order to comply in every way with the Lumen Christi College dress code and uphold the standard that is expected of all attending students, the Uniform Shop will only accept second hand stock of a saleable quality:

- All items must be presented in a clean, freshly laundered and ironed state on coat hangers. Blazers must be dry cleaned with a receipt attached as evidence of this.
- Items must be current style and display the current logo.
- Items which are faded, torn, have stains, defects or vastly altered hems will not be accepted.
- Swimwear, socks, stockings, hats, school bags, accessories or stationery will not be accepted.

The Uniform Shop reserves the right not to accept items for which it may have an oversupply of stock, for items that have become obsolete due to uniform changes or for items not originally purchased from the uniform shop.

Second hand items accepted by the Uniform Shop will be available for re-sale for a period of **SIX MONTHS ONLY** from the date on which they are made available for re-sale. Blazers will be available for a period of **TWELVE MONTHS ONLY**, from the date on which they are made available for re-sale. Only after the six month or twelve month period (respectively) has passed, will any payment be forth coming to the parent/guardian who is named and has signed the consignment agreement.

All bank details must be given on the consignment agreement, including bank and account names as well as BSB and account numbers.

Notice in writing must be given to request the return of any unsold items at the end of the six or twelve month period. After this time a notice will be forwarded outlining the amounts (if any) due to be credited to you with a reminder of the time needed to collect unsold items. If this time lapses or if you have signed this agreement NOT to collect unsold items, the Uniform Shop will take no responsibility for these and may choose to either discard them or forward them to charity.

Personal information collected and stored by Perm-A-Pleat is subject to the Privacy Act and the Perm-A-Pleat Privacy Policy Statement. A copy can be obtained from the uniform shop.
